## READY TO USE (RTU) DISINFECTION PROTOCOL

### ONE

Thoroughly wet surface with PREempt<sup>™</sup> RTU.

Remove any visible dirt or debris from surface, object or equipment prior to disinfecting.



### TWO

Allow to remain wet for **3 minutes** to kill viruses, bacteria and fungi.

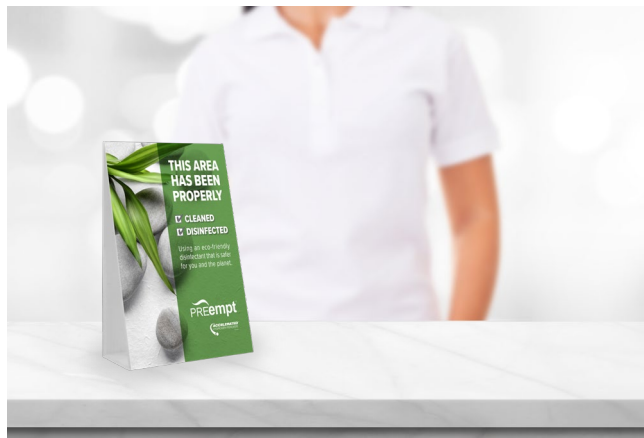

### THREE

Leave to air dry.

Optionally wipe any excess solution using clean cloth after required contact time has been achieved.



### BEST PRACTICES

- Disinfection should take place **after each and every** client service or treatment to prevent the spread of germs and infection.
- During any kind of an outbreak or seasonal flu, use a **checklist** and have salon/spa staff routinely disinfect those items throughout the day. Proper hand hygiene should be performed following cleaning and disinfection.
- Bottles should not be topped up with fresh solution and the containers should be cleaned and dried prior to reusing.

### DISINFECTION CHECKLIST

- Hair, nail and wax work stations
- Esthetic and massage treatment areas
- Equipment such as hot cabinets, steamers, magnifying lamps, nail dryers and drying lamps
- Front desk / reception
- Doorknobs and door handles
- Common area surfaces, racks, shelves
- Washroom surfaces
- Chairs, counters, tables and all seating areas
- Employee lockers and lunchroom
